If English is not your native language you will be asked to provide evidence of your competence in English.

International English Language Tests (IELTS) are one of the Secure English Language Tests (SELTs) which are accepted as evidence (of your proficiency for the English language) by the UK Visas and Immigration department (UKVI). The tests are taken at an approved IELTS testing centre.

See the list below of other tests, scores and time limits (if any) that can provide evidence of English Language Level.

Cambridge English Advanced	Grade C	No expiry
IELTS (Academic) <i>Online test is not accepted</i>	6.0 with no lower than 5.5 in any element.	2 years
TOEFL	87 overall (Reading 22, Listening 21, Speaking 23, Writing 21)	2 years
Pearson Test of Academic English (PTE) <i>Home Edition is not accepted</i>	Listening – 51 Reading – 51 Writing – 51 Speaking - 51	2 years
GCSE or GCE 'O' level	Grade C	No expiry
International Baccalaureate	Must have completed the Diploma with English at Higher Level	No expiry
WEAC/NECO	C6 or above	No expiry

There can sometimes be long waiting times for a Language Test place, so you should make arrangements to take a test as soon as possible, and to allow time for a retest should one be required.

If you have a valid, acceptable language test report you will be required to upload images or scans of your test reports on the University of Huddersfield application portal.
